### A NOTE FROM THE SCHOOL BOARD

Dear Parents:

Many of you have taken the opportunity to review the Southwest POD Task Force presentation to Bishop Finn. If you have not done so yet, the presentation is available on Sycamore. One of the five key foundational pillars of the plan is stewardship, particularly, an emphasis in the parishes on a life-long, year-round commitment to stewardship.

This month our nation observes the Thanksgiving Holiday. Joyful appreciation of the blessings we have received is the first characteristic of a true steward. Why is this important? Because without recognition that God has given us all things, including our children, we will not be able to fully commit our time, money, prayers and personal service to advancing the mission of the church.

As of this writing, the Bishop has not yet approved the Southwest POD Task Force recommendation. However, before a parish wide focus on stewardship can begin, we all must discern our own discipleship commitment by:

- Praying for the wisdom to understand our unique calls to discipleship.

KINDERGARTEN ROUNDUP NOVEMBER 10

**Kindergarten Roundup for the 2010-2011** school year will be held on Tuesday, November 10 @ 6:30 p.m. in the school library. Kindergarten Roundup is an informational meeting for parents - you will be given important information about our school and our kindergarten program. To give you a head start on gathering documents, you will need a county/state issued copy of your child's birth certificate and a copy of your child's baptismal certificate as part of the registration process. If your child was baptized at St. Elizabeth and you do not have a copy of their baptismal certificate, you will need to contact the parish office to get one. If your child is currently in our preschool, your immunization records will be on file. If not, immunization records must be submitted with the registration form as well. Registrations are not complete without these documents. The kindergarten registration fee for 2010-2011 is \$530. A fifty percent deposit of \$265 is due with the registration form and documents. The balance is due by January 30, 2010 to hold your spot. The entire registration fee is non-refundable. Tuition rates have not yet been set for the new year. All fees and tuition rates are subject to change.

Please call Nancy Miller in the school office to RSVP for Kindergarten Roundup. Let us know your name, your student's name and whether one or both parents will attend.

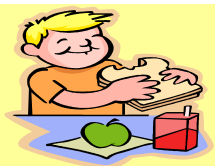
